**18** The word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord:

- <sup>2</sup> "Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will let you hear my words."
  - <sup>3</sup> So I went down to the potter's house, and there he was working at his wheel.
- <sup>4</sup> And the vessel he was making of clay was spoiled in the potter's hand, and he reworked it into another vessel, as it seemed good to the potter to do.

  <sup>5</sup> Then the word of the Lord came to me:
- 6 "O house of Israel, can I not do with you as this potter has done? declares the Lord. Behold, like the clay in the potter's hand, so are you in my hand, O house of Israel.
- <sup>7</sup> If at any time I declare concerning a nation or a kingdom, that I will pluck up and break down and destroy it,
- 8 and if that nation, concerning which I have spoken, turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I intended to do to it.
- 9 And if at any time I declare concerning a nation or a kingdom that I will build and plant it,
- 10 and if it does evil in my sight, not listening to my voice, then I will relent of the good that I had intended to do to it.
- <sup>11</sup> Now, therefore, say to the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem: 'Thus says the Lord, Behold, I am shaping disaster against you and devising a plan against you. Return, every one from his evil way, and amend your ways and your deeds.'
- 12 "But they say, 'That is in vain! We will follow our own plans, and will every one act according to the stubbornness of his evil heart.'
